#### SCHOOL BOARD

#### What it is. What it does.

The board of education, also called the school board, is a unit of local government that establishes direction, goals, and priorities for a school district and determines policy, budget, leadership, and administration.

The Board of Education consists of seven elected or appointed officials who each serve a four-year term. These are unpaid, volunteer positions. Board elections are held during the month of April as part of the consolidated election cycle in odd numbered years.

As are reminder, for a school concern, the best place to begin is with those directly involved: The teacher for a student-related or classroom concern for example, or the principal regarding a school regulation or practice. If the first point of contact is unclear, contact the district office for guidance on the appropriate chain of command.


