## Policy 4:175

The Superintendent or designee shall perform fingerprint-based criminal history records information checks and/or screenings required by State law or Board policy for employees. ; studentSstudent teachers must provide a copy of a fingerprint-based criminal history report.; students Sstudents doing field or clinical experience other than student teaching; contractors' employees who have direct, daily contact with one or more children; and resource persons and volunteers must provide a valid ID daily. These visitors will be screened against the sex offender registry and custom databases, including those with custody orders and banned visitor status. The Board President shall ensure that these checks are completed for the Superintendent. The Superintendent He or she shall take appropriate action based on the result of any criminal background check and/or screen.
