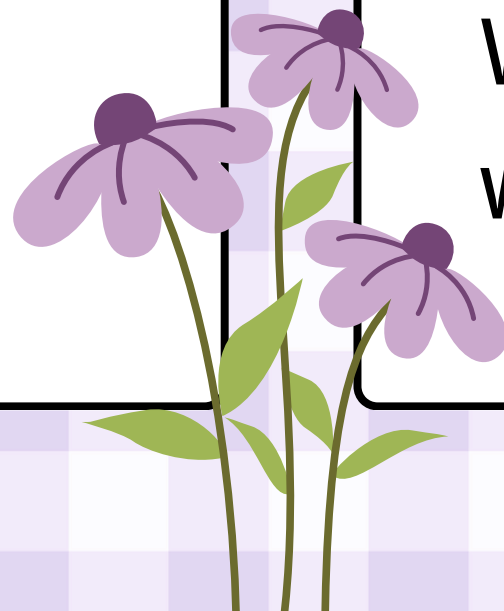
Curriculum Fees

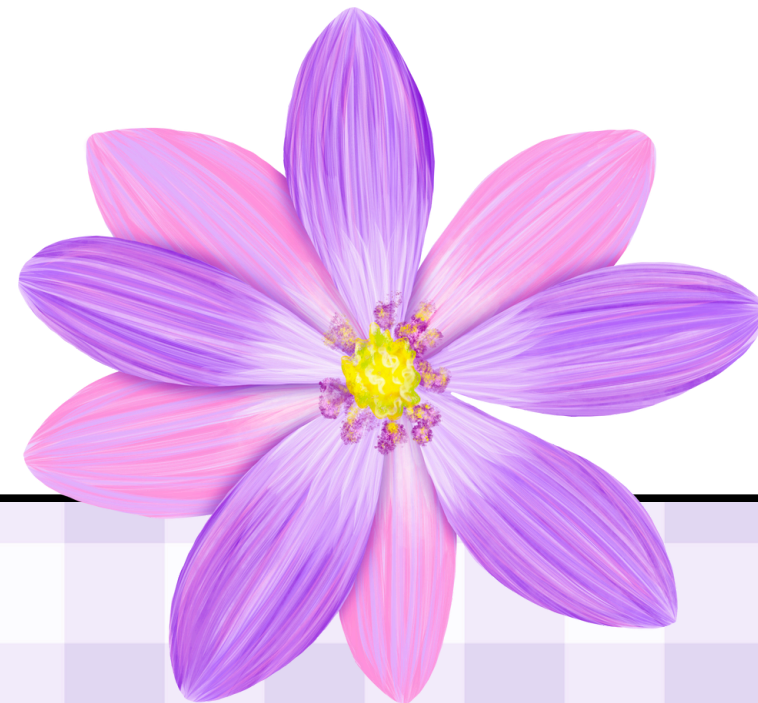

Next month I will ask the Board to approve the engagement letter with WIPFLI for the FY25 Audit

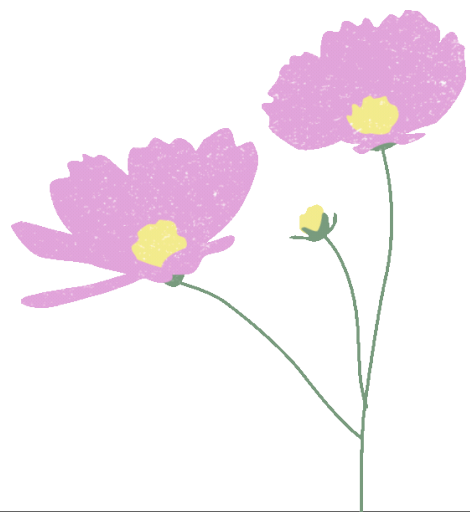

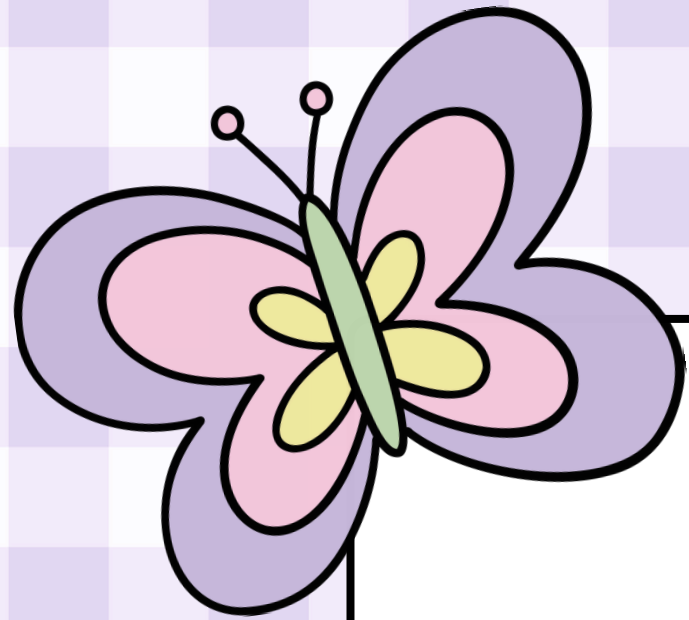
