

























## About our ML Students

- Norridge School District 80 currently services
  327 students Who are identified as Multilingual (ML).
- These are students who have exposure to a different language other than English at home.
- Our ML Students represent 28 different languages!
- Any child who is identified as ML must take the ACCESS test.







# What is the ACCESS Test?

- ACCESS for ELLs is an annual English language proficiency assessment required by federal and state law.
- Given to all identified English Learners, usually between January and March.



# What are the core areas of ACCESS?

### ACCESS

ACCESS measures English language proficiency in four domains:

- Listening
- Speaking
- Reading
- Writing

Students are also scored across composite areas:

- Overall Composite Score (a Weighted average of the 4 domains)
- Literacy Composite (reading and writing)
- Oral Composite (speaking and listening)
- Comprehension Composite (reading and listening)

## How do students exit ML services?

#### Exiting ML Services

- To exit ML services, students must score:
  - An Overall Composite score of 4.8 or higher on the ACCESS for ELLs.
  - This score indicates that the student is proficient in English for academic purposes.



This year, we had <u>38 students</u> who scored high enough to exit out of our program! This is a huge celebration both for our students for their hard work and dedication, as well as to our teachers for their unwavering support of our diverse learners.
